Details of Activity (500 words):	<p>As a part of the First Year Student Induction Program "Vidyasanskar", Session 4 was conducted on the topic "Anti-Ragging Cell Awareness" with a total duration of four hours, scheduled from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. The session was organized with the primary objective of creating awareness among newly admitted first-year students about the Anti-Ragging Cell, its objectives, functions, and the importance of maintaining a safe, respectful, and ragging-free campus environment at Ashokrao Mane Group of Institutions (AMGOI).</p> <p>The awareness session was conducted by Dr. S. G. Chonde, who addressed the students in a systematic and interactive manner. The session commenced with an introduction to the First Year Student Induction Program "Vidyasanskar", highlighting its role in shaping students' academic, professional, and ethical values. Dr. Chonde then introduced the concept of ragging, explaining its definition as per UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations, and emphasized that ragging in</p>

any form—physical, verbal, psychological, or online—is a punishable offense.

The speaker sensitized students to the **adverse physical, emotional, and psychological effects of ragging**, stressing that such practices negatively impact individual well-being as well as the overall academic atmosphere. The importance of mutual respect, discipline, empathy, and responsible behavior among students was emphasized in alignment with the core values of the **“Vidyasanskar” induction program**.

Dr. Chonde elaborated on the **structure, objectives, and functioning of the Anti-Ragging Cell at AMGOI**. He explained the composition of the cell, which includes faculty members, administrative staff, and designated representatives, and described how the cell works proactively to prevent ragging incidents through monitoring, awareness activities, and continuous interaction with students. The institution’s **zero-tolerance policy towards ragging** was clearly communicated, assuring students of a safe and inclusive learning environment.

The session further covered the **preventive and monitoring measures** adopted by the institute, such as mentoring systems, surprise inspections, counseling support, and coordination with hostel authorities. Students were informed about the **legal consequences and disciplinary actions** under UGC guidelines, including suspension, expulsion, cancellation of admission, and legal proceedings, to reinforce the seriousness of the issue.

Special emphasis was laid on the **procedure for reporting ragging incidents**. Students were guided on how to approach members of the Anti-Ragging Cell, faculty mentors, institutional authorities, and helpline services. The confidentiality of complaints and protection of complainants were assured, encouraging students to report any incident without fear or hesitation.

The session concluded with an **interactive question-and-answer session**, where students actively participated and clarified their doubts regarding campus safety, discipline, and student support systems. Overall, the session conducted under the **“Vidyasanskar” First Year Student Induction Program** was informative and impactful, effectively reinforcing AMGOI’s commitment to maintaining a **ragging-free, disciplined, and student-friendly academic environment**.

Outcomes of Activity:

1. Increased awareness among students regarding anti-ragging rules and institutional policies
2. Enhanced confidence among students to report ragging incidents without fear
3. Promotion of a respectful, inclusive, and ragging-free campus environment
4. Improved understanding of students’ rights and responsibilities as per UGC regulations
5. Strengthened trust in institutional support systems and grievance redressal mechanisms
6. Early identification and prevention of potential ragging-related issues
7. Development of ethical values, empathy, and responsible behavior among students
8. Better interaction and rapport between first-year students, faculty, and administration
