Eligibility Criteria

(As per Government of Maharashtra CET Cell Guidelines)

A. First Year Admission (2 Years Duration)

Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates

The candidate must:

- Be an **Indian citizen**
 - Hold a **minimum 3-year Bachelor's Degree** in any discipline
 - From a **UGC / AIU recognized university**
 - With **at least 50% marks in aggregate** (or **45%** for **Reserved / EWS / PwD** candidates from Maharashtra)
 - Have obtained a **non-zero score** in **MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2026** conducted by the **Competent Authority**

All India Candidates, including J&K & Ladakh Migrants

The candidate must:

- Be an **Indian citizen**
 - Hold a **minimum 3-year Bachelor's Degree** in any discipline
 - From a **UGC / AIU recognized university**
 - With **at least 50% marks in aggregate** (or **45%** for **Reserved / EWS / PwD** candidates from Maharashtra)
 - Have obtained a **non-zero positive score** in **any one** of the following entrance exams:
 - **MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2026**
 - **CAT** (by IIMs)
 - **CMAT** (by NTA)
 - **XAT** (by XLRI, Jamshedpur)
 - **ATMA** (by AIMS)
 - **MAT** (by AIMA)
 - **GMAT** (by GMAC, USA)

B. Second Year (Lateral Entry) Admission

For Maharashtra State & All India Candidature Candidates

The candidate must:

- Be an **Indian citizen**
- Have passed any of the following degrees:
 - **B.E.** (Bachelor of Engineering)
 - **B.Tech.** (Bachelor of Technology)
 - **BBA** (Bachelor of Business Administration)
 - **BMS** (Bachelor of Management Studies - 4-year program)
 - Fulfill any additional conditions declared by the **Competent Authority** from time to time

Note: Submit original documents in person at the time of admission reporting. Attested copies are to be submitted as applicable.
